BACKGROUND

Climate Change and ESG

According to S&P Global Market Intelligence, "80% of the world's largest companies are reporting exposure to physical or market transition risks associated with climate change", while "increasing pressure from shareholders and activists has led to divestment from some carbon-intensive industries". In response to risks associated with climate change, many ESG (Environment, Social and Governance) efforts have been paid and focused on the assessment of those material climate impact ².

Adopting the global TCFD reporting framework (Task-force on Climate-related Financial Disclosure) by the listed companies is also required in Hong Kong by the Hong Kong Stock Exchange (HKEX) on or before 2050. It is envisaged the needs for the harmonization work between the new ISSB (International Sustainability Standard Board) standards and the current GRI (Global Reporting Initiatives) requirements for both local and international issuers.

Climate change is the highest priority ESG issue facing investors. The intention of the new standards is to deliver a comprehensive global baseline of sustainability-related reporting standards, providing investors and other capital market participants with information about companies' sustainability-related risks and opportunities so as to help them make informed decisions.

Based on the 3 stages of Sustainable Finance typology, our economic model is migrating to the third stage of development. The private sector has a role to play, making a contribution to sustainable development while observing financial viability³. The enterprise nowadays should be a 'purpose' entity⁴, creating net positive projects, and making a positive impact and contribution to society in the upcoming regenerative era⁵.

This conference, on the one hand, will equip enterprises to link their approach to creating long-term, sustainable value, contributing positively to sustainable development in line with the SDGs. On the other hand, it provides an experience exchange platform to help investors protect portfolios from risks and to expose them to opportunities in the shift to a low-carbon global economy.

Asia-Pacific Green Deal for Business

Apart from the important topics of ESG, this year's theme is the "Asia-Pacific Green Deal for Business" - the first of its kinds in Asia and is an initiative of the ESCAP Sustainable Business Network, which advocates for business leadership in implementing the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development.

The Green Deal for Business calls upon businesses to contribute to the necessary green transformation to ensure that serious reductions in carbon emissions can be achieved, and our economy be put on a more sustainable footing. It specifically appeals to

- Green finance
- Green innovation
- · Green production, consumption and waste

International trends and global expectations

It is becoming increasingly clear that the combined drivers of regulatory requirements and financial incentives will likely shape future trends in climate change assessment and disclosure. In this vein, following the successful organisation of the first and second meeting in 2019, and 2021, ESCAP has partnered with the World Green Organisation (WGO) once again to organise the third Sustainable Investing and ESG Conference in 2022 in Hong Kong, China. The Conference will gather policymakers and representatives of private business, financial institutions, international organisations, family offices and foundations and other relevant stakeholders to discuss pressing issues in promoting climate-resilient investment to finance the SDGs.

OBJECTIVES

Building on the successful 2019 and 2021 conferences, The World Green Organisation and ESCAP are organising the third edition of the Sustainable Investing and ESG Conference in 2022 with the following objectives:

- 1) Propose innovative finance to improve the sustainability reporting and disclosure quality and hence increase the confidence in sustainable investment
- 2) Identify best practices for environmental, social and governance (ESG) investment, mainstreaming, accessing and leveraging finance for climate risk evaluation and adaptation
- Develop a common understanding of the latest trends, successes, and challenges with Asia-Pacific Green Deal for Business, engaging project proponents, potential investors and business corporations to pledge and make a contribution to SDGs

- 5) Raise awareness about climate and sustainable finance and strengthen the capacity of stakeholders to develop an enabling policy environment in ASEAN countries


PARTICIPANTS
