## FOREWORD

#### Hong Kong as a Green Finance Hub

I am delighted that the United Nations Climate Finance Conference is being held in Hong Kong. A very warm welcome to all the participants, and I trust that you will have an interesting and insightful event.

Hong Kong is Asia's premier international financial centre and a regional hub for green finance. One of the Government's major initiatives is the establishment of a government green bond programme with a borrowing ceiling of US\$12.8bn. This will finance projects with environmental benefits under our public works programme. In addition, the Hong Kong Quality Assurance Agency operates a green finance certification scheme for both bonds and funds. The Government has also launched a Green Bond Grant Scheme and a Pilot Bond Grant Scheme that provide subsidies to attract more bond issuance in Hong Kong.

In 2018, around US\$11bn worth of green bonds was issued in Hong Kong. Issuers included entities from Hong Kong, Mainland China and abroad, as well as multilateral development banks such as the World Bank, the Asian Development Bank and the European Investment Bank. We are confident that this momentum will continue and multiply, helping to make our world a greener one.
